Third Quarter Report on Donations Approved by OPGS for FY 2010

Pursuant to Mayor's Order 2010-60 dated April 6, 2010, the Director of the Office of Partnerships and Grant Services (OPGS), in consultation with the Office of the Attorney General's Ethics Counselor, is publishing the District's Third Quarter Report on Donations for Fiscal Year 2010. The Order requires the OPGS Director to review all requests by District officials to solicit or accept donations and approve or disapprove such requests as appropriate in accordance with the Rules of Conduct Governing Donations (Mayor Memorandum 2010-1) and Section 115 of the D.C. Appropriations Act. This report includes data on all donation requests submitted to the OPGS Director for the period beginning April 1, 2010 and ending June 30, 2010. During this period, the OPGS Director approved the solicitation and/or acceptance of \$8,994,209.59 in donations of which \$137,940.94 represented financial contributions and \$8,856,268.65 were in-kind donations.
