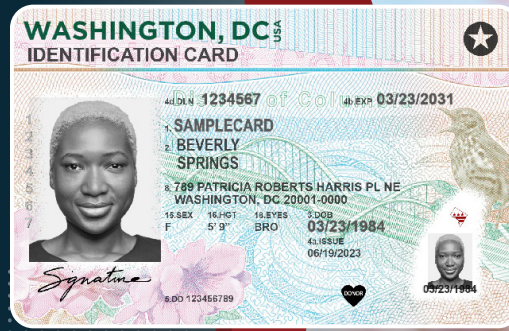

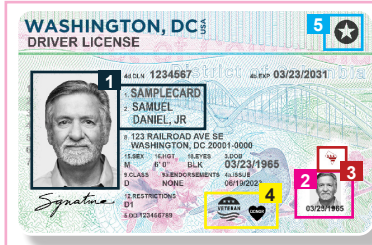


What You Need to Know

Effective July 17, 2023, DC DMV will launch a redesigned driver license and identification (ID) card, incorporating iconic DC landmarks and imagery. This new design, along with the current customer application process, incorporates updated security features to reduce identity theft. After applying, customers will receive a temporary paper license or ID card that is valid for 45 days. They should get a new credential by mail approximately two weeks from issuance.

ENTIRE CARD

- Polycarbonate card body with reflective surface embossing
- Design features vibrant colors and iconic images (including cherry blossoms, a Wood Thrush bird and the Frederick Douglass Memorial Bridge)

FRONT SIDE

- Secure, laser-engraved portrait photo and card holder data
- New dynamic security feature flips between showing secondary portrait photo and date of birth as card is tilted
- Additional images of "DC" abbreviation and District map with inset flag are revealed above the secondary photo as card is tilted
- Redesigned veteran and organ donor insignias
- Travel-ready REAL ID compliant credential features a star in top right corner
- Limited purpose credential is indicated with "NOT VALID FOR OFFICIAL FEDERAL PURPOSES" statement at the top

- District of Columbia seal featured prominently
- Identification barcode
- Cardholder signature shown
