Points Waiver Information

District of Columbia law provides for the assessment of traffic violation points to your driver record for minor moving violations. Under the District of Columbia's point system, your driver license or privilege to operate a motor vehicle in the District of Columbia can be suspended for the accumulation of 8 to 10 points over a 2 year period. If you accumulate 12 or more points over two years, your driver license, or privilege to operate a motor vehicle in the District of Columbia, will be revoked for at least six months.

DC law allows for the waiver of traffic violation points for good driving behavior. Not all minor traffic violations carry points and photo enforcement violations do not carry points.

You may only request a waiver of points if you have answered the ticket in a timely manner and no decision has been made on your ticket. This includes the denial of a Motion to Vacate Default Judgment. You must admit to the violation and you must pay the ticket fine.

To request the waiver of points, you must make application in writing at the same time that you pay your ticket fine. You must provide a written statement for review by a hearing examiner. In the statement, please explain why you believe the points should not be assessed for the violation.

The examiner will review your statement and determine whether to grant your request based on the seriousness of the violation and your driving history. Include any evidence that may support your statement. A current driving record is not required, but may be helpful.

Complete the form on Page 2 and mail it to **DMV, Adjudication Services, Request for Points Waiver**, PO Box 37135, Washington, DC 20013. You will be informed of the decision by mail within thirty days.
