

DC DMV REAL ID CREDENTIAL NOTICE

IMPORTANT: Effective October 1, 2015, the DC DMV Driver License Fee will increase from \$44 to \$47.

Starting May 1, 2014, the District of Columbia Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) will begin issuing a REAL ID Driver License and REAL ID Identification Card. The REAL ID driver license and REAL ID identification card will replace our current driver license/identification card and requires a one-time re-validation of source documents when you obtain a first-time DC credential, renew your DC credential or obtain a duplicate credential (for lost, stolen or address changes). This revalidation will enable the DC DMV to ensure your identity, current residency and issue a federally compliant REAL ID driver license and identification card. The new requirements will affect what you will need to bring to the DC DMV office when obtaining a first time credential, renewing your expiring credential or obtaining a duplicate (which includes change of address) credential. Online and mail-in renewal is not an option for you on or after May 1, 2014 until your documents have been revalidated and you receive the REAL ID driver license or identification card. The REAL ID credential has a star in the upper right hand corner. Note: A document that is being used as Proof of Identity cannot also be used as Proof of Social Security Number

Proof of Identity – Full Legal Name and Date of Birth

Must bring ONE (1) of the following items listed below and must be original:

- United States birth certificate or birth certification card filed with a State Office of Vital Statistics
- Valid REAL ID driver license, learner permit, or identification card
- Unexpired United States Passport
- Certificate of Naturalization
- Certificate of US Citizenship
- Consular Report of Birth Abroad (CRBA) issued by the US Department of State
- Unexpired Foreign Passport w/visa and I-94 reflecting duration of stay
- Unexpired Foreign Passport w/visa (classification A and G), I-94, and US State Department Letter (reflecting no diplomatic immunity)
- Unexpired Foreign Passport w/visa (classification F), I-94 and I-20
- Unexpired Foreign Passport w/visa (classification J), I-94 and DS-2019
- Unexpired Employment Authorization Card
- Unexpired Permanent Resident Card
- I-94 stamped Asylee and Asylum Approval Letter
- I-94 stamped Refugee
- *Letter with picture from Court Services and Offender Supervision Agency (CSOSA) or DC Department of Corrections (DC DOC) certifying name, date of birth, social security number and address (for 6-month ID card only)

*Exception process may only be used to receive a 6-months identification card if none of the other acceptable documents are available. Upon renewal, CSOSA and DOC applicants will be required to undergo the revalidation process by providing source documents, excluding the CSOSA or DOC sole source document (i.e., CSOSA & DOC Sole Source Document will not be an acceptable document to use for revalidation after the 6-months ID card has expired).

DC DMV REAL ID CREDENTIAL NOTICE

Proof of Social Security Number

You must bring ONE (1) of the following items listed below and must be original (which includes computer printouts for pay statements, W-2s, 1099s):

- Social Security Card bearing applicant's name, SSN, and signature
- Pay statement reflecting full name and full SSN
- W-2 (wage and tax statement) reflecting full name and full SSN
- 1099 Form reflecting full name and full SSN

Proof of Current District of Columbia Residency

You must bring TWO (2) of the following items listed below, must be original (which includes computer printouts for online bills) AND contain a valid DC address (P.O. Boxes not acceptable):

- Utility bill (water, gas, electric, oil, or cable), with name and address, issued within the last 60 days (disconnect notices/bills are not accepted)
- Telephone bill (cell phone, wireless, or pager bills acceptable), reflecting applicant's name and current address, issued within the last 60 days (disconnect notices/bills are not accepted)
- Deed, mortgage, or settlement agreement reflecting applicant's name and property address issued within the last 60 days
- Unexpired lease or rental agreement with the name of the applicant listed as the lessee, permitted resident, or renter (may be a photocopy)
- DC property tax bill issued within the last 12 months reflecting the applicant's name and property address
- Unexpired homeowner's or renter's insurance policy reflecting name and address
- **Letter with picture from Court Services and Offender Supervision Agency (CSOSA) or DC Department of Corrections (DC DOC) certifying name and DC residency issued within the last 60 days
- DC DMV Proof of Residency Certification for Residents Under 21 Years of Age Form signed by the parent/guardian residing at the residence AND a copy of parent/guardian's unexpired DC driver license or DC identification card AND 2 proof of residency documents (i.e., utility bill, telephone bill, etc.) in the parent/guardian's name.
- DC DMV Proof of Residency Certification For Au Pair Form
- Bank/Credit Card/Investment Account Statement issued within the last 60 days reflecting name and address
- Official Mail—received from ANY government agency(with full name and address) to include contents and envelope received within the last 60 days, excluding mail from DC DMV
- **DC DMV-approved form from certified social service provider
- Medical Bill issued within the last 60 days reflecting name and address
- Student Loan Statement issued within the last 60 days reflecting name and address
- Home Line of Equity Statement issued within the last 60 days reflecting name and address
- Car/Personal Loan Statement (no coupon books/vouchers accepted) issued within the last 60 days reflecting name and address
- Home Security System Bill issued within the last 60 days reflecting name and address

**May only be used to obtain an Identification Card and does NOT require a second source of residency document

Documents that are altered, counterfeit, torn, laminated, erased, whited out, etc. are not originals and are not accepted by DC DMV.
