## WAIVER OF REGISTRATION WITH THE UNITED STATES SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM

In accordance with Federal law, any male, United States citizen or immigrant who is at least 18, but less than 26 years of age, must register with Selective Service.

Pursuant to the "Access to Selective Service Registration Amendment Act of 2012", I am choosing <u>NOT</u> to use the drive license or identification card application as a means of registering with the Selective Service System.

If required to register, I understand I must be registered with Selective Service to be eligible for the following Federal benefits associated with the registration requirement:

- Federal Student Aid (to include Pell Grant)
- Job training under the Workforce Investment Act (WIA)
- Federal Employment
- Employment with the US Postal Service
- Citizenship, if I am a US Immigrant

I also understand that failure to register with Selective Service is a felony punishable by up to five years in prison and a \$250,000 dollar fine. In addition, by failing to register, as required, I could permanently lose those benefits associated with the registration requirement.

I am exercising my right to refuse to register with Selective Service via the DC DMV driver license or identification card application process.
