### District DMV Locations to Close for Veterans Day

(WASHINGTON, DC) – In honor of Veterans Day, all [District of Columbia Department of Motor Vehicles](#) (DC DMV) locations will be closed on Saturday, November 10, and Monday, November 12, 2018. Regular business hours will resume on Tuesday, November 13.

Customers are encouraged to plan ahead and “Know Before You Go” for services requiring an in-person visit to a Service Center as customer volume is high before and after a holiday closing.
